Roll call and the introduction of guests

Chair's Report

Report to the Board of Supervisors: Commissioner Obringer reported to the Commission on the presentation. Only herself and Commissioner Duckworth were able to attend, but it went very well. Special acknowledgement to Commissioner Obringer's mom for taking the photos, which will be used in the upcoming newsletter.

Miscellaneous: Commissioner Obringer spoke about the planning retreat, and asked the Commission to determine a date. Consensus was for May 4th, a Saturday. Commissioner Obringer also mentioned an upcoming event honoring women to be hosted/sponsored by Assemblymember Susan Bonilla.

Approval of January Minutes: Commissioner McDonald moved, and Commissioner Gordon seconded approval of the minutes. Commissioners Reed and Davila-Luevano abstained, all others present voted in favor, and the motion passed.
